Retreat in Daily Life starting soon.....

This six-week opportunity for intentional prayer while continuing normal routines is available in several areas and at different times in coming months:

How does it work?

- A gathering of pilgrims and prayer guides gets you started;
- Spend half an hour privately each day reflecting on a Bible passage or with other prayer material;
- Meet 30-40 minutes once a week with your prayer guide reflecting on what happens in your prayer;
- A concluding gathering, draws the 'retreat' to a close

- You choose the time and place of your private prayer, and negotiate a time and place to meet weekly with your prayer guide.
- The venue for the two gathered sessions is in the area named, but pilgrims participate from near and far.
