Welcome to the 4<sup>th</sup> issue of 'Pipeline', a monthly article about our magnificent pipe organ, saved from the now closed church of St Thomas Bedford, Leigh. As promised, monitoring of humidity and temperature has now begun both at Spinners Mill, where the organ is stored and at Holy Trinity, the organ's eventual new home. Also, reassuringly, maintenance of the roof two storeys above the organ is well under way. A view of a few of the now vertically-stored soft metal pipes can be seen below.

As well as high-quality Holy Trinity coasters featuring Simon Filsell's amazing photography of our church, we now have Holy Trinity key rings on sale at the welcome desk. There will shortly be good quality pens available as well. All proceeds are for the Organ Appeal. You can order any of these from Lynn Jones or Chris Howard.
