## Organ Pipeline No. 6 - April 2019

**Welcome** to the 6<sup>th</sup> issue of 'Pipeline', a monthly article about our magnificent Harrison & Harrison pipe organ, saved from the now closed church of St Thomas Bedford, Leigh. This month you can read here excerpts from the history of this iconic instrument.



The organ was built in 1920/1921 by Harrison & Harrison of Durham at a cost of £4,263. The opening recital was given on 27<sup>th</sup> April 1921 by Sir **Edward Bairstow** (pictured left), Master of Music at York Minster.

Later that year, on October 19<sup>th</sup>, no less a figure that **Marcel Dupré** (pictured right) gave a recital. Dupré was by then among the top international recitalists in the world, The previous year he had performed the complete organ works of J.S.Bach in a series of ten concerts entirely from memory! Three years later he was appointed Professor of Organ at the Paris Conservatoire.



A sign of the organ's quality is demonstrated by the willingness of cathedral organists to offer recitals throughout its history and into the 21<sup>st</sup> century. **James Lancelot** of Durham Cathedral wrote in 2008 'I was immediately struck by the quality of the instrument in terms both of construction and of musical excellence'. Also in 2008, **Kerry Beaumont** of Coventry Cathedral commented on 'the quality of workmanship and tonal excellence of the instrument'. He continued, 'I have played a great many organs around the country, and a good many Harrisons too. Yours is certainly a gem!'
