Messy Church is Holy Trinity's successful outreach to families unfamiliar with church. We run six times each year - and we're recruiting!

- **Messy Muscle** has two shifts. From 1:00-2:30pm, its members set up tables, chairs and whatever else is needed. Then from 5:30-7:00pm, they clear up, sweep up in the church building, help wash up and put things away in the kitchen. You could join one or both shifts.
- **Messy Meals** works between about 2:00 and 6:00pm, preparing and serving food under the direction of the catering manager.

These are opportunities to serve God as part of a friendly team, doing something worthwhile that always blesses our guests. The dates are fixed well in advance to help teams plan. To be a pilgrim: new year, new sermon series

Journeys - the Bible's full of them. Journeys of fear and trepidation, of joy, hope and freedom. Journeys that seem solitary. Journeys on which many, many people travel together. And not least, journeys on which people evolve and grow in God, discovering more of who they're supposed to be.

From the first Sunday of the New Year until Easter, the theme of our sermon series *To be a pilgrim* (Sunday 9.30/11.00 and Tuesday 1.00 services) is journeys. But if the Bible's a journey from start to finish, it's not one that goes in a straight line. It's marked by some lengthy detours and unexpected incidents along the way. And all sorts of people travelling for all sorts of reasons, in all sorts of states of mind.

What about us? Are our bags packed? Are we ready and excited? Or perhaps fearful? If we're willing to be transformed together, following in the footsteps of Jesus, we're travelling – whatever state we're in. And if we're a church for everyone, all kinds of travellers will be joining us, too.

We hope the series will have something for everyone: new perspectives, challenges, and resources to give hope and expectation for the journey as we discover more about what our life might look like when we travel on with the God who loves us.
