New Electoral Roll – Deadline this SUNDAY 27 April 2025

There is still time to ensure you are on the new electoral roll for 2025. You have until the end of Sunday 27th April to ensure your name is published on the new roll, ready for the Annual Parochial Meeting in May.

- If your name is on the 2024/2025 you will still need to reapply for 2025/2026.
- Each person will need to apply individually (i.e. if a partner/spouse or parent has filled in a form, you will still have to complete your own form.

You apply for the electoral roll if you are:

(a) baptised

(b) aged 16 or over, and

(c) have habitually attended Holy Trinity for at least six months **or** you live in the parish

How can I make sure I am included on the new Electoral Roll?

Annual Meeting – 18th May at 11am in Holy Trinity

Each Parish Church is required to hold an Annual Meeting of Parishioners at which the Church Wardens are elected, and an Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) at which the Parochial Church Council (PCC) presents reports to the Church on any changes to the Electoral Roll; the finances of the Church; the Building and Fabric; and on the activities of the Diocese and Deanery that the Parish Church belongs to. New PCC members are also elected for a 3-year term at the APCM.

There are vacancies for 4 PCC members. If you are interested in standing for election there are nomination forms available on the Church website or by the PCC noticeboard. There is also a description of the responsibilities and a list of meeting dates available.

Mission focus, May 2025 – Embrace Warwickshire

Embrace is a Christian organisation supporting female on-street sex workers in Coventry, with a new branch recently started in Birmingham. They aim to build relationships, demonstrating that each woman is deeply loved and precious to God, and that they are seen, known and loved. Volunteers meet the women on the streets, and offer food, drink, hygiene products, conversation, and prayer when appropriate. Later their project manager provides further support, helping to stabilise their lives, working with other agencies in the city as needed.

2025 Coventry Half Marathon & 10k Road Closures - Sunday 27th April, 9:00am

Please note the below information:

- Holyhead Road will only be closed towards the city centre; traffic flow will still be maintained from the city centre towards Allesley.
- Radford Road will be only closed for traffic heading away from the city centre; traffic flow will still be enabled towards the city centre however there will be a diversion from Lydgate Road using Sandy Lane back onto Radford Road further down
- Tamworth Road will also only be closed for traffic heading away from the city centre; traffic flow will still be enabled towards the city centre
- Access along B4544 Little Park Street towards Coventry Cathedral and Salt Lane Multi Storey Car Park will be enabled until 08:45 (from the A4053 only) and re-opened for 09:45 once all runners have passed.
